On the Cover

Baal's Bridge Square.

This old brass square, recovered from the foundations of Baal's Bridge in Limerick in 1830, bears the inscription "I will strive to live with Love and Care Upon the Level By the Square" and bears the date, 1507. Kept in the archives of Antient Union 13 Lodge in Limerick, Ireland, this Square was presented to Brother Michael Furnell, Provincial Grand Master, by Brother James Pain, who had been the contractor for rebuilding the bridge in 1831. The date of construction of the "old" bridge has not been ascertained, but it is mentioned in records of 1558.




differences between people. Practical assistance such as giving money is important but it is a charitable attitude which is paramount and it is this that Freemasons are taught in their Lodges.
